CHAMBERSBURG, PA, July 18, 2011— On June 14, 2011, six year old Calvin McLaughlin was involved in a tragic accident. Calvin, the son of Serena Harne and step-son of ALL-SHRED Employee Randy Harne, was in an accident involving a lawn mower resulting in a below the knee amputation for Calvin.

Mary Pat Kulina, ALL-SHRED owner, says, "Calvin is home recovering now but the family is facing a mountain of medical bills as additional surgeries are required. With limited medical coverage and extensive care needed, the bills are piling up quickly. Randy and his family are an important part of our ALL-SHRED family so we all want to help. We are quickly mobilizing our staff and the community to raise funds to help offset the medical bills. Several fundraisers have been scheduled in conjunction with the Chambersburg Cardinals' home games. ALL-SHRED will have one of its mobile shredding trucks at the July 23rd, August 6th and August 13th games. Prior to kickoff, fans can bring documents to be shredded. In lieu of the shredding fee, donations will be accepted for Calvin and his family."
