## CHAMBERSBURG CARDINALS SHUT OUT LANCASTER LIGHTNING

LANCASTER, PA, Saturday, July 30, 2011 the Cardinals shut out the Lancaster Lightning 56-0 at Manheim Township Athletic Complex. Running back Keon Lattimore had a stand out night, scoring four touchdowns, three on the ground.

"It all worked out the way it should," Fauson said. "We finally put together four quarters and played well in all facets of the game. It was like a weight was lifted off my shoulders."

Backup quarterback Josh Finafrock also had a stand out night, highlighting a last-minute start with three touchdown passes.

"Lattimore put on a show," Fauson said. "Everything just meshed well. The offense built confidence from the first series on. It was nowhere near as sloppy as the way we've played all season."

Lattimore detonated three touchdown runs of 57, 81 and 22 yards, respectively. Even more, he capped the Cardinals' scoring by catching a fourth-quarter touchdown pass from Finafrock. Lattimore, in his first season with Chambersburg, leads the Cardinals with 10 total touchdowns.

Jerrell Jones scored twice, with a 70-yard punt return for Cardinal's first score. He also caught a 22-yard pass from Finafrock.

Ron Frazier accounted for the Cardinals' other touchdown, when he returned a fumble 12 yards for a score in the first quarter. Substitute kicker Tim Miller was eight for eight on extra point attempts.

Fauson said, "If we keep things going like this, I can't wait to see what happens next."

Finafrock stepped in for quarterback Anthony Gardner, who couldn't make the game because of car trouble. The veteran backup entered the game having completed only three of nine passes this season, but made up for lost time by completing his first touchdown pass of the season when he connected with Ron Dawkins in the second quarter.
