CARDINALS THUNDER OVER LIGHTNING, 70-7 FINAL

CHAMBERSBURG, PA, July 6, 2011—The Chambersburg Cardinals Professional Football Team rolled over the Lancaster Lightning Saturday night for their first home game of the season. The final score was 70-7, Chambersburg.

The Cardinals defense held the Lightning to negative 11 yards rushing, while Chambersburg counted 367 yards of total offense for the game, 213 of which were on the ground.

“I don’t think you ever go into a game expecting to score 70 points,” Chambersburg’s head coach Chad Fauson said. “You know you have a good football team and you know you do some things well, but you never go in expecting to outscore your opponent by 63 points.”

Running back Keon Lattimore, who fumbled on the Cardinal’s second play from scrimmage, quickly redeemed himself by scoring Chambersburg’s first touchdown of the night. Running back Andre McDonald who also lost a fumble, scored two minutes later for the second touchdown. McDonald also secured two more touchdowns late in the game.

Lancaster secured their only touchdown at the beginning of the fourth quarter with a 41 yard reception by Jarome Larue. The play accounted for more than half of the Lightning’s total passing yardage for the game.

“We knew about Chambersburg,” Lancaster coach Rob Ford said. “They come out and execute real well. They do all the little things right that allow a football team to win. They’re talented across the board.”

Chambersburg gears up for their next home game Saturday, July 9 against the South Jersey Lynx.
