CARDINALS TRUMP LYNX 38-8

CHAMBERSBURG, PA, July 11, 2011—The Chambersburg Cardinals Professional Football Team stood their ground against the South Jersey Lynx Saturday evening, claiming a 38-8 victory. This is the third consecutive win for the Cardinals this season.

The win keeps the currently undefeated Cardinals at the top of their division in the Gridiron Developmental Football League.

Cardinals Wide Receiver Ottis Lewis started the game out on a positive note when he caught an 18 yard pass from Quarterback Anthony Gardner in the first quarter for the team's first touchdown. This was the first of three touchdowns for Lewis.

"I felt I missed some opportunities last week," stated Lewis. "I thought I owed the fans a couple long bombs."

"Lewis is 6 foot 6 and is a tough guy to cover," Cardinals Head Coach Chad Fauson said. "He creates mismatches every week. What can I say? He's just a good football player."

Defensive End Michael Bibbs intercepted in the second quarter, giving the Cardinals the advantage. Lewis quickly landed a touchdown. Shortly after, Gardner ran for a 6 yard touchdown, putting the score at 24-0 at halftime.

After two more Cardinal touchdowns in the fourth quarter, South Jersey's Edward Dover squeezed past the Cardinals defense for their only touchdown to close the game. Fauson still continued to praise the Cardinals defense, however, stating that "they were solid again" and continued to excel even with the loss of former teammate Louis Corum who was recently signed by the Virginia Destroyers of the UFL.

The Cardinals are getting ready to go out on the road this coming weekend as they face the Bergen Hawks Saturday in Palisades Park, New Jersey. They return home July 23 to face the DC Explosion at 7:00 pm.
